

The biggest Superpipe of Austria at the Kitzsteinhorn

For a few weeks now, the Snowpark Kitzsteinhorn has an all-new attraction on offer. Besides the two diverse park areas of the Easy Park and the Central Park, there is now an additional feature for all freeskiers and snowboarders: The biggest and best Superpipe of Austria.

A gigantic construction project

With a **length of 135m** and a **height of 6.30m** (20 feet), the u-shaped pipe is truly unique in its construction. After intense snow production at the pipe area already during mid of December, the incredible **25.000m³ of snow** which had been produced at the pipe entrance, were spread over the whole Superpipe. After having completed the basis construction, the optimum aptitudes as well as the perfect radius were milled into the huge walls with the Zaugg Monster Pipe Cutter. Thus safe drop-ins at an angle of almost 90° and flowing runs with massive airtime are guaranteed to all Superpipe fans.

Perfect training conditions

The final result is an impressive piece of snowpark design, of which also **Snowpark Kitzsteinhorn parkdesigner Stefan Plattner** is proud of: *"With a length of 135m and a height of 6m30, the Superpipe at the Kitzsteinhorn is really unique in its form and size and definitely not comparable to any other pipe project in Austria. Our overall aim was to produce a high-quality Superpipe from the very first, which – in combination with frequent reshaping - remains in its shape as long as possible and which can be used as a perfect training compound for pipe riders from all over Europe."* Despite its gigantic dimension, the Superpipe is also a real attraction for less advanced freeskiers and snowboarders. The elliptic form guarantees enough landing space and hence cares for sufficient safety. The Superpipe Kitzsteinhorn is **opened daily from 9am to 3pm** and can be shredded by all snowboarders and freeskiers.

Besides the Superpipe, the Snowpark Kitzsteinhorn offers a diverse Snowpark setup for riders of every level with its **Easy Park** and the **Central Park**. The recently finished **pro line** with massive **kickers** between **15m** and **17m** has already drawn the attention of international film and photo crews and will also stage the 9th **Austrian Freeski Open**, where the European freeski elite will battle for fame, glory and prize money from the **23th – 27th February 2011**.

All young guns who want to enjoy the freestyle and freeride paradise Kitzsteinhorn, can take advantage of the **"power of ten"** day ticket campaign. All visitors between 6 and 19 years (born between 1992 and 2004) only pay **10 Euros** every Saturday throughout the season for a day ticket.
